### 2025 Tree Planting Initiative

Last year we have grown the Kendall Ag in the Classroom program to reach 7,454 students, averaging 1,000 students a month in K-12th grades. Students ended the school year learning about pollinators and got to make their own "Throw and Grow" seed ball planting multi colored zinnia seeds.

This school year we have 3 unique presentations on pork, pizza, and compost. All programs are free of cost thanks to our donors and partners.
